ANNUAL ROAD REHABILITATION PROJECT

Beginning Monday, August 28, and continuing through October 2017, Knife River Construction will commence work on the City's Annual Road Rehabilitation project. The project will be located along portions of East First Avenue, from Bryant Avenue to Madrone Avenue; Longfellow Avenue, from East First Avenue to the south end of the bridge over Lindo Channel; and Hooker Oak Avenue, from Madrone Avenue to Manzanita Avenue. The work, in general, consists of roadway surface treatments and ADA curb ramp replacements.

Local access throughout the project construction zone will be subject to traffic controls and temporary delays in order to accommodate construction crews and equipment. One-lane traffic may be in effect at times. Drivers are encouraged to build extra time into their schedules or plan alternate routes to avoid the project area if possible. There may be times when access to driveways is limited to allow for the surface treatments to cure. The City acknowledges this temporary inconvenience and appreciates your cooperation and patience during this time.
