FINAL PAVING ON COHASSET ROAD CITY OF CHICO'S FIRST SB1 GAS TAX FUNDED ROAD REHABILITATION PROJECT

On Wednesday, June 6, 2018, the City of Chico's contractor, Knife River Construction, will begin the final paving operations on the Cohasset Road Rehabilitation Project between East Avenue and Eaton Road. Final paving will commence through the week and will be completed on Friday, June 8, 2018.

During paving operations and associated construction activities, traffic controls will be in place, including lane closures, appropriate advanced notice signage, and work zone delineators. However, two-way traffic on the four lane facility will be maintained and flaggers will be manning the closure limits to assist drivers in accessing properties/destinations within the construction area. Local access throughout the project construction zone will be subject to temporary delays. Drivers are encouraged to build extra time into their schedules, plan alternative routes to avoid the project area when possible, and drive with caution to avoid hazards and maximize the safety of workers in the roadway.

Residents and businesses can expect temporary increases in equipment noise near active work areas. Typical work hours will be from 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Wednesday through Friday. The City acknowledges that the increases in noise and temporary traffic delays are inconvenient and appreciates your cooperation and patience during this time.
