Ribbon Cutting Ceremony:

The City of Chico is pleased to announce the completion of the Lindo Channel Bicycle Bridge Rehabilitation Project. The 302 foot long bridge is located at the southern end of Ceres Avenue between Manzanita and East Lindo Avenues. The Rehabilitation Project reflects the community's vision to enhance public safety while improving the City's bicycle network.

Vehicles may park along Manzanita or East Lindo Avenues, however biking or walking to the event is encouraged as parking is limited.

Project Improvements:

Project elements included bridge deck replacement and public safety improvements. Specifically, the existing wood decking was replaced with light-weight reinforced concrete decking. In addition, low-level bridge lighting, two street lights and security cameras were installed. The bridge provides a critical link along the City's Bikeway 99 route and serves as an important high water crossing over the Lindo Channel for both bicycles and pedestrians.
