NARRATIVE:

The Chico Police Department is currently in the process of completing a follow-up investigation concerning this case and would like to update the public. After a careful review of this investigation, it has been decided to submit our investigation to the Butte County District Attorney for review of potential Animal Abuse charges. As it stands, we have information which indicates the owner of the dog has relinquished custody to a third party. We are in the process of confirming this information. We are committed to ensuring that a complete and accurate investigation is conducted, and that the dog in question is appropriately cared for. The Chico Police Department asks citizens to please allow the judicial process to proceed in this case.

Update to the original press release

On 11-26-16 at approximately 10:00, Chico Police took possession of the Husky dog in this case. It was confirmed the dog was not with the suspect, but rather was located at an area animal shelter. The dog was taken to a local Veterinarian where a thorough examination was completed. The Veterinarian found the dog to be completely healthy and injury free. The dog will be cared for and remain within the possession of the Chico Police Department until further notice.
